Course Aims

This Master's Law degree has been designed to meet the needs of a wide range of highly skilled and professional people (not all of whom will be practising lawyers) who need to acquire specialist knowledge of legal issues.

In addition, it will appeal to law graduates seeking a professional career who wish to acquire specialist knowledge in order to practise more effectively or to enhance their career prospects.

The aim of the course is to provide a coherent scheme of advanced academic study leading to a thorough and critical understanding of relevant legal rules as well as the intellectual, social and economic forces that shape the legal policies which establish those rules

Course Structure

Students can elect to study for a general LLM, or they can elect to specialise in a variety in a identified pathways*, within which they may choose selected units, in the following fields:

- Environmental Law
- European Union Law
- Employment Law
- International Law
- Intellectual Property Law

In addition, a postgraduate research project leading to a dissertation (of approximately 20,000 words) will be undertaken within your chosen field.

* Pathways will run subject to demand.

Course Aims

The MA Management and 'Pathway' Programme includes a number of Masters' degrees which share a common core of management and research.

Each of the different pathways provides an in-depth specialisation in a specific subject area. The course aims to:-

- Develop the skills of independent learning and enquiry
- Acquire knowledge at an advanced level
- Use knowledge to evaluate organisational issues
- Resolve uncertainty and ambiguity
- Discuss and communicate complex and abstract ideas
- Execute and present a substantial research investigation

Management Foundation Course

This is a 5-week intensive course that precedes the MA (see Entry Requirements). The course starts in September and covers the following subjects:

- Managing People
- Economics
- Operations Management
- Managing Information
- Finance
- Marketing

Entry Level

The normal entry is with a degree in business or management.

Note: For graduates in a non-business subject area or who do not have a UK degree, the Management Foundation Course must be taken and passed to gain entry to the MA.

No employment experience is required, so the MA can be taken directly on becoming a graduate.

If English is not your first language, you will be asked to show evidence of fluency in written and spoken English (eg, an IELTS score of 6.5 or above).

MA Unit Exemptions

If you hold a postgraduate qualification, it may be possible to gain exemptions from units of this MA.
